The mission of the Cave Creek Rodeo Days is to maintain the highest level of professional rodeo event, and to preserve and promote our Western Heritage in Cave Creek to benefit the businesses, the communities in the Sonoran Desert.

When: March 27 – March 29, 2020

Where: Memorial Arena Rodeo Grounds, 37201 N 28th St, Cave Creek, AZ 85331

Directions: Off of Carefree Highway, go north on 32nd St., turn left onto E. Cloud Road, Take the 1st right onto N 28th St. Destination is at the north end of 28th St.

Why: Cave Creek Rodeo Days started in 1977 and has energized the community, bringing major economic benefits and the nation's leading rodeo contestants in to showcase their talents.

Attendance: In 2019, over 12,000 people went through the gates for the 3-day performance.

Rodeo: Once again Cervi Championship Rodeo will be the stock contractor for the Cave Creek Rodeo Days. As a team, the Cervi family oversees and participates in every aspect of rodeo production from preserving sought-after bloodlines, to directing the audience experience at the arena floor. In 2019, the Cave Creek Rodeo Days had a payout of \$61,099 and because of its continued success we have been able to increase the amount every year.

Rodeo Theme Night's: Friday, March 27, Tough Enough to Wear Pink, Saturday, March 28, Man Up Crusade, Purple/Turquoise Rodeo Colors, Sunday, March 29, Wrangler National Patriots Day, Red/White/Blue day.

Awards: Justin Best Footing Award 1st Place 2017, Justin Best Footing Award 2nd Place 2018. The Justin Best Footing Awards® program focuses on the health and well being of the animal athlete. Not only does the program keep animal athletes performing at the top level, but it also recognizes the hard work and time rodeo committees put into making their ground as safe as possible for the barrel horse and all rodeo livestock.

Stockman's Club: Tickets are \$150.00 per person, per performance. Stockman's Club has a maximum capacity of 300 people. Stockman's Club is an enhanced experience including special seating, unlimited beverages, host bar and a complimentary buffet served at each performance, and admission to the General Admission area to shop our vendors.

Ranchero Club: Tickets are \$50.00 per person, per performance. The Ranchero Club has a maximum capacity of 220 people. The Ranchero Club includes special seating, two beverage tickets, Ranchero bar and complementary food served at each performance. In addition to the experience, during each performance there are special drawings to win a Yeti cooler worth a value of \$300.00+.

Chute 6: Tickets are \$200.00 per person, per performance. Chute 6 has a maximum capacity of 20 people. Chute 6 includes special seating, unlimited beverages, host bar, a complimentary buffet served at each performance in Stockman's Club and admission to the General Admission area to shop our vendors.

Attire: Put on your favorite hat and boots! Festive cowboy attire is **always welcome**, but not required. A light jacket or sweater is recommended if joining us in the evening.

Weather: The rodeo will be held unless it is potentially dangerous for the contestants and/or livestock.

Clear Bag Policy: Any bag larger than the permissible size is prohibited, unless credentialed personnel carrying such belongings have been thoroughly searched. Visit our website www.cavecreekrodeo.com for more details.

DEMOGRAPHIC INFORMATION

The Cave Creek Rodeo Days draws thousands of visitors annually to Cave Creek, Arizona during the three-day event, creating a noticeable influx of consumers in the area.

Cave Creek, Arizona has a population of 5,476 with a median household income of \$76,149. The median property value is \$465,500.

The Cave Creek Rodeo Days is entering the 43rd year in Cave Creek. Marketing statewide continues to be a critical element to developing fan excitement.

The Professional Rodeo Company Association (PRCA) headquartered in Colorado Springs, is the largest and oldest rodeo-sanctioning body in the world. Annually, the PRCA sanctions about 600 top-of-the-line multiple-event rodeos on the continent, in about 38 states and three or four Canadian provinces.

According to the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association Inc. (PRCA), rodeo is one of the fastest growing sports in the U.S.

- More than 36 million people identify themselves as fans of Pro Rodeo, and many of them attend PRCA-sanctioned rodeos around the country annually. According to the Sports Business Daily, rodeo is seventh in overall attendance for major sporting events, ahead of golf and tennis.
- All PRCA rodeo events involve livestock, and the care of those animals fall on the stock contractors who buy or breed them, raise them, feed them, provide medical care when necessary and transport them safely between rodeos.
- The PRCA's 6.3 million loyal attendees across the U.S. are about 49 percent male and 51 percent female, 51 percent have household income of \$50,000 and more than 67 percent own their own homes.
- Unlike most other professional sports, most contestants are paid salaries regardless of how well they do, cowboys generally pay to enter each rodeo. In 2016, the PRCA's membership included 4,692 cowboys, who comprise the majority of the association's roster. The PRCA includes one \$6-million earner, four \$3 million earners and more than 100 million-dollar earners, yet most of its competing members participate in fewer than 30 rodeos per year.

“RODEO UNDER THE STARS”

Cave Creek’s Memorial Arena Rodeo Grounds is a year-round rodeo facility. Cave Creek Rodeo Days has utilized the arena for 43 years. New bleachers were added in 2013, 2015, and 2017 with a capacity of 2500+ people (handicap seating available). Equestrian homes border the rodeo facility.

Each year the Stockman’s Club, the Ranchero Club and Chute 6 host over 500 people and consist of the patronage, of our rodeo fans, from throughout the country.
